

Human trafficking is the modern-day form of slavery. Victims of trafficking are subjected to force, fraud, or coercion, for the purpose of sexual exploitation or forced labor. There are currently over 27 million slaves worldwide, of which over 50% are children. Approximately 600,000 to 800,000 people annually are trafficked across international borders, and thousands are trafficked into the United States.

Sandie is a Registered Nurse and has served on the board of the International Nurses Association in Athens, Greece where she lived for ten years. It was there that she discovered human trafficking while doing a story for Lydia Living magazine. She also serves as Director of Vanguard University's Global Center for Women and Justice and is adjunct professor of Family Violence and Human Trafficking—www.vanguard.edu/gcwj. Sandie served as a Human Trafficking Dialogue Facilitator at the National Association of Evangelicals Global Leaders Forum in Washington D.C. and was invited to the first Whitehouse Roundtable on Human Trafficking. Sandie Morgan is Administrator of the Orange County Human Trafficking Task Force enlisting the local community in partnership with law enforcement against the modern slave trade.

Correlation of Pornography to Trafficking

Jean Morgan has been a pastor and teacher worldwide for over 30 years. He served in the US Navy from 1969 – 1975. Following his military service he attended Vanguard University (then, Southern California College) in Costa Mesa, CA to prepare for fulltime ministry. He graduated with a B.A. in Religion and a B.A. in Psychology. He then pastored churches for 8 years prior to joining the Assemblies of God World Missions team as a missionary. His passion is to present on the impact pornography has on human trafficking. Jean believes slowing demand is a cornerstone when developing strategies to rescue, rebuild, and restore women, men, and children who are victims of human trafficking and sexual exploitation.
